**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible for the **Jack M. Wilson Presidential Scholarship**, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be currently enrolled at one of the UMass campuses - Amherst, Boston, Dartmouth, Lowell, and Worcester or be currently studying online and enrolled for at least six (6) credits in an academic program through UMassOnline.
- Have an overall GPA of 3.25, with a minimum of fifteen (15) credits earned at the UMass. UMass Worcester students must be in good standing.
- Preference for Business, Engineering and Physics majors. Preference for students of any major studying abroad.

**APPLICATION: Submit your completed application with: 1. Resume; 2. Transcript (unofficial is acceptable), Letter of Recommendation and 3. An essay about your public service. The essay should not exceed 750 words.**
