The Fellowship comes with a \$1000 stipend and financial support for project research and travel. Fellows also receive mentorship from our post-doc residents, participate in workshops as a cohort, attend 5COLLDH events, share their work on our website, and present at the spring 5COLLDH Student Symposium.
